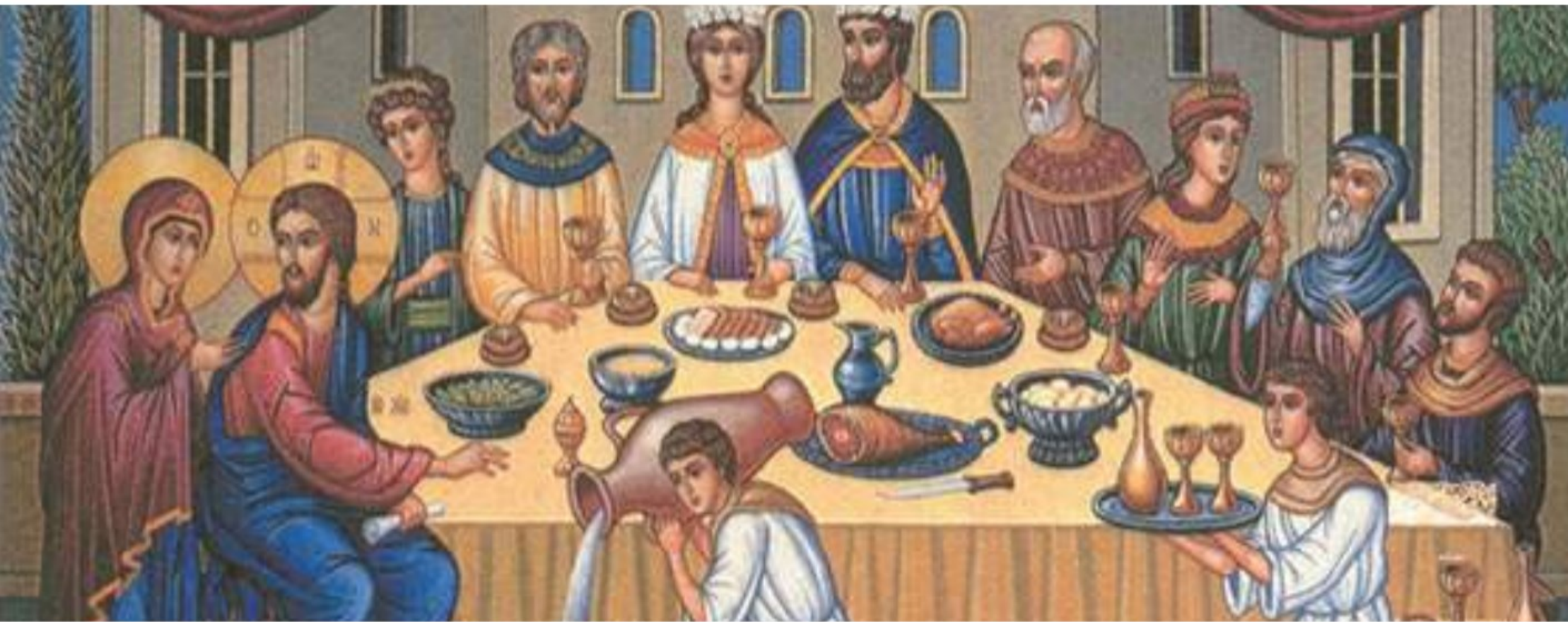

A SPIRITUAL DROP FROM OUR PASTOR "SECOND SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME"

As you know I studied and lived in Spain for 8 years, it was a wonderful time where I learned many things including to distinguish a good wine from a bad one, although at the beginning it was not like that because I remember that when I finished drinking just the first glass I could not hold myself when I walked and everyone laughed at me. The book of Sirach says: "Wine and music make the heart glad" (Sir. 40:20) But what can we do when the good wine runs out? That is, when joy, hope, love, peace, the desire to keep going, the desires of being saints end... Then comes sadness and we believe that all is lost. This happens because we have trusted ourselves a lot, but we have not trusted God enough. Let us never trust in our human strengths because sooner or later they will run out, let us always trust in the Divine strength and wisdom that comes from on high to keep us firm on this path of holiness. If you have run out of the wine of love, patience, hope or joy, never forget that only He can renew us, refresh us and even make us new. Like Mary, let us always do what He commands us. God loves you with infinite tenderness. Happy Sunday!

WORD OF LIFE

2nd Sunday in Ordinary Time: Do Whatever He Tells You

“There was a wedding at Cana in Galilee, and the mother of Jesus was there. Jesus and his disciples were also invited to the wedding. When the wine ran short, the mother of Jesus said to him, ‘They have no wine.’ And Jesus said to her, ‘Woman, how does your concern affect me? My hour has not yet come.’ His mother said to the servers, ‘Do whatever he tells you.’” (Jn 2:1-11)

At the wedding feast in Cana, many things were brought to light. One of them was that Jesus counted on the support of God, just as His disciples did when they saw the miracle of the transformation of water into wine. Another was His blessing our human love, and with it, instituting the Sacrament of Matrimony.

But that, and much more, could only happen thanks to the presence of the Virgin Mary there. She was the one who urged Jesus to have mercy on the wedding couple, from which it is easy to deduce that she knew her Son could perform miracles. And, above all, she was the one who left us one of the most beautiful phrases of the New Testament, which has become an entire life plan: “Do whatever He tells you.”

Ever since then, Mary always shows herself to us as the one who permanently directs us to her Son urging us to obey Him. She encourages us to do so even if we don't understand, just as what happened to the servants who filled up the jars without knowing the miracle that was going to happen. She asks us to obey, to follow Christ, not only to bring her Son joy, but also because it is best for us. Christ has given us enough reasons to trust in Him, in His word, and in His will. But if for whatever reason we feel distant from Him, look to Mary: trust her, obey her. She, who has always been beside us, will show us the way: Do whatever He tells you.

ASPIRATIONS:

Do whatever God asks of you—fulfill your duties, the commandments, just as they are taught by the Church—even if you don't understand them and have doubts.

PALABRA DE VIDA

Domingo II: Haced lo que Él os diga

“Había una boda en Caná de Galilea y la madre de Jesús estaba allí; Jesús y sus discípulos estaban también invitados a la boda. Faltó el vino y la madre de Jesús le dijo: ‘No les queda vino’. Jesús le contestó: ‘Mujer, déjame, todavía no ha llegado mi hora’. Su madre dijo a los sirvientes: Haced lo que Él os diga.” (Jn 2, 1-11)

En las bodas de Caná se pusieron de manifiesto muchas cosas. Una de ellas fue el apoyo por parte de Dios con que contaba Cristo, como pudieron comprobar sus discípulos al ver el milagro de la transformación del agua en vino. Otra fue la bendición del amor humano y, con ello, la institución del sacramento del matrimonio.

Pero eso, y mucho más, pudo ocurrir gracias a que allí estaba la Virgen María. Ella fue la que instó a Jesús a apiadarse de la pareja de novios, de lo cual es fácil deducir que ella sabía que su hijo podía hacer milagros. Y, sobre todo, ella fue la que nos dejó una de las frases más hermosas del Nuevo Testamento, que se han convertido en todo un programa de vida: “Haced lo que Él os diga”.

María se nos muestra siempre, desde ese instante, como la que señala permanentemente hacia su Hijo instándonos a obedecerle. Nos anima a hacerlo incluso aunque no entendamos, como les debió ocurrir a los criados que llenaron los cántaros de agua sin saber el milagro que se iba a producir. Nos pide que obedezcamos, que sigamos a Cristo, no sólo para darle una alegría a Él, su Hijo, sino porque eso es lo mejor para nosotros. Cristo te ha dado motivos suficientes para fiarte de Él, de su palabra, de su voluntad. Pero, si por cualquier causa te sientes alejado de Él, fíjate en María: fíate de ella, hazla caso. Ella, que siempre ha estado junto a ti, te señala el camino: Haced lo que él os diga.

Propósito: Hacer lo que Dios me pida -cumplir con mis obligaciones, con los mandamientos tal y como los enseña la Iglesia- aunque no lo entienda e incluso aunque tenga dudas.

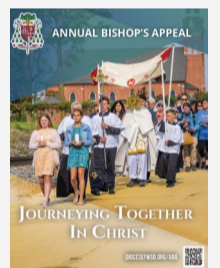
Queridos feligreses,
