WORD OF LIFE

**33rd Sunday in Ordinary Time:
Obey the Only Word that Gives Life**

"Heaven and earth will pass away, but my words will not pass away." (Mark 13: 31)

The words of Christ, the authentic presence of Christ Himself, will never be spoken in vain. Not only are they not out of date, but if they are listened to with the ears of the soul, they will never cease to bear fruit in the heart of man.

But for His words to be heard, we have to know how to silence the other voices. Sometimes, these voices are within and come from our own selfishness and instincts. At other times, the voices are outside of us. They strive to dislodge God from being first in our hearts so that they may occupy it themselves along with those who subscribe to their preaching. And so, it is advisable to examine our conscience to discover if it is the words of Christ, His message transmitted through the Church, that guides our lives, or if it is that of others, celebrities, politicians, and journalists who have taken His place. Although these "words of men" are presented to our intelligence and to our interests in a seductive and attractive way, we must not forget that the same has happened on other occasions in the past with tragic consequences for the people and the nations that heeded them, like Nazism or Marxism. Only the words of Christ, the "word of God" produces life. Only they tell us the truth, even that part of the truth that stings us, that exposes our sins before our eyes and which we would prefer remain hidden.

Therefore, let's make an effort to accept the word of the Lord, in its entirety, without allowing anyone to censure it either within our hearts or outside of ourselves. And then, as seriously as possible, let's try to put it into practice.


Pero para eso, para que se las escuche, hay que saber hacer callar a otras voces. A veces éstas proceden de nuestros egoísmos e instintos. En otras ocasiones son voces que están fuera de nosotros y que pugnan por desbancar a Dios del primer lugar de nuestro corazón para ocuparlo ellas y los que las pronuncian. Conviene, pues, examinar nuestra conciencia para descubrir si son las palabras de Cristo, su mensaje transmitido a través de la Iglesia, el que guía nuestra vida o si son otros -los famosos, los políticos, los periodistas- los que han ocupado su lugar. Aunque estas "palabras de hombres" se presenten ante nuestra inteligencia y ante nuestros intereses de una manera seductora, atractiva, no debemos olvidar que lo mismo ha sucedido ya en otras ocasiones en el pasado, con trágicas consecuencias para las personas y los pueblos que las escucharon, como el nazismo o el marxismo. Sólo las palabras de Cristo, la "palabra de Dios" produce vida. Sólo ella nos dice la verdad, incluso aquella parte de la verdad que nos escuece, que desnuda ante nuestros ojos nuestros pecados, esos que querríamos que permanecieran ocultos.

Hagamos, por lo tanto, un esfuerzo por acoger la palabra del Señor íntegramente, sin permitir que nadie la censure en nuestro corazón o fuera de nosotros. Y, después, intentemos con la mayor seriedad posible llevarla a la práctica.

Propósito: Analizar nuestros criterios, nuestros valores, nuestras normas morales, para ver si son coherentes con la enseñanza de Cristo o con lo que dice la gente y opina el mundo.




