

In spite of this, there were families much poorer than mine who had nothing to live on, no clothes, no shoes, no television, no cars, no vacations, nothing ..... Their daily bread was tears. My mother always shared with them what little we had and she always taught us to pray for them and told us: "God always provides". We are so preoccupied with having, power, satisfaction, pleasure... because all that gives us human security. Today Jesus invites us to abandon ourselves to Him and to entrust our present and our future to Him because He always provides. Give your fears to Him. God loves you with infinite tenderness. # **WORD OF LIFE**

# 15th Sunday in Ordinary Time: **Evangelize Even Though You** Don't Feel Prepared

"He summoned the Twelve and began to send them out two by two and gave them authority over unclean spirits." He instructed them to take nothing for the journey but a walking stick - no food, no sack, no money in their belts." (Mark 6: 7-8)

We are living in times that, in a way, can be compared to those of the first Christians. Not in vain did Pope John Paul II and some bishops describe this situation as "neopaganism." Our situation, so similar to that, is characterized by the rejection or indifference with which the message of Jesus is received. It is common to hear complaints about what apostleship demands, about the shame that we go through when we have to defend the Church in the workplace or even in the family. Furthermore, because we are Christians, we seem to be guilty of all imaginable crimes, of all the sins that the rest of Christianity has committed throughout history (Inquisition, Crusades, etc.), real, invented or exaggerated. Because of these similarities, it is worth noting precisely what the early Christians did. They did not have it easier since they were even risking their lives. However, they had the courage to face a hostile environment and they won. Perhaps the differences between them and us are not in the difficulties of the environment, nor that they had more material means to evangelize, but that they had more faith, more love for Christ, more conviction that being a Christian was extremely fortunate. For this reason, although we should try to have better evangelizing techniques – such as communication media – what we must do, above all, is to have more spiritual means, more prayer, and more and better witnesses to life.

**Purpose:** Do not allow yourself to be overcome by environmental pressures as you are professing your faith. Be well-prepared by finding explanations for the doubts and objections you will face. Then, evangelize....


